RESOLUTION 136

Election of Members of the Council

The General Conference,

Recalling that, according to the provisions of Article 10, paragraph 2, of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America, the Members of the Council shall hold office for a period of 4 years, and that the outgoing Members shall not be eligible for re-election for the following period;

Bearing in mind that the term of office of two Members of the Council, Jamaica and Venezuela, comes to an end in September, 1981;

Taking into consideration that the Governments of Peru and Mexico have presented their candidacies for occupying the vacant posts,

Resolves:

To thank Jamaica and Venezuela for their work in the Council and to accept the candidacies presented by the Governments of Peru and Mexico and to designate them Members of the Council of OPANAL for a period of 4 years, to commence in September, 1981 and to end in September, 1985.
