RESOLUTION 158 (VIII)

ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

The General Conference,

Recalling that, by virtue of the provisions of Article 10, paragraph 2 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America, the term of office of the Members of the Council shall be for a period of 4 years and that the out-going Members shall not be eligible for re-election for the following period;

Bearing in mind that three of the Members of the Council: Colombia, Honduras and Uruguay, have completed their term of office in September 1983;

Taking into consideration that the Governments of Jamaica, Panama and Venezuela have proposed candidates to occupy the vacancies,

Resolves:

To thank Colombia, Honduras and Uruguay for their efforts and to accept the candidatures of Jamaica, Ecuador and Venezuela and to appoint them as Members of the Council of OPANAL, for a period of 4 years which shall begin in September 1983 and shall terminate in September 1987.
