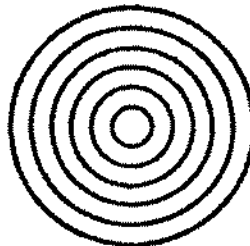

RESOLUTION 173 (VIII)

STATUS OF THE CONVENTION ON THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES

The General Conference,

Mindful of Resolutions 37 (II) dated September 9, 1971; 2 (I-E) dated November 6, 1972; 50 (III) dated August 23, 1973; 70 (IV) dated April 17, 1975; 93 (V) dated April 21, 1977; 126 (VI) dated April 26, 1979 and 140 (VII) dated April 24, 1981, in all of which have been made repeatedly calls to the Governments of Member States which are not yet Parties to the Convention on the Privileges and Immunities of the Agency, to proceed to sign and ratify this instrument as early as possible, and

Having examined in detail the status of the signatures and ratifications of the said Convention, as it appears in the Annex to the Memorandum from the Secretary General included in document CG/239,

Resolves:

To request the Governments of Member States which have not yet signed this Convention, to do so as early as possible, and those which, having signed, have not yet ratified it, to do so at the first opportunity, so that the legal status of the Agency, based on Article 7 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America may make use of the facilities which they ought to be enjoyed in each of the Member States for the full exercise of its functions.
