RESOLUTION 178 (VIII)

WORKING CAPITAL FUND

REPORT OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS
AND BUDGETARY MATTERS

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind Resolutions 6 (I), where the Working Capital Fund was set up, 64 (III), in which the proportion of 10% of the General Fund was fixed as the total of the Working Capital Fund;

Recalling that the Budget for the Working Capital Fund for the biennium 1982-1983 amounts to \$46,152.55, and for the biennium 1984-1985 amounts to \$48,372.40 and that the difference between both is \$2,219.85;

Having analyzed document CG/248 presented by the Committee for Contributions and Budgetary Matters,

Resolves:

1. That for financial years 1984-1985, the Working Capital Fund is to be increased by \$2,219.85, corresponding to 10% of the General Fund of the same biennium.
2. That the amount mentioned in the preceding paragraph is to be increased in accordance with the apportionment assigned to the States, according to the Scale established by the General Conference for said financial year.
