RESOLUTION 184 (IX)

ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

The General Conference,

Recalling that in accordance with Article 10, paragraph 2 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America, the Members of the Council will remain in office for a period of four years and that outgoing Members may not be re-elected for the following period;

Bearing in mind that the term of office of two of the Members of the Council, Mexico and Peru, expires on 30 August 1985;

Taking into account that the Governments of Costa Rica and Uruguay have proposed candidates to occupy the upcoming vacancies,

Resolves:

To express its thanks to Mexico and Peru for the fulfillment of their duties and to accept the candidates proposed by the Governments of Costa Rica and Uruguay and appoint them Members of the Council of OPANAL for a period of four years, beginning on 1 September 1985 and ending on 30 August 1989.
