## **RESOLUTION 273 (XII)**

### **STATUS OF THE TREATY AND ITS ADDITIONAL PROTOCOLS**

The General Conference,

NOTING that the Governments of the Netherlands, the United Kingdom, the United States and France have signed Additional Protocol I and that the latter has been ratified by the Netherlands, the United Kingdom and the United States;

NOTING ALSO that the Governments of the United Kingdom, the United States, France, China and the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics have signed and ratified Additional Protocol II;

RECALLING Resolution 172 (VIII) of May 18, 1983, in reference to the status of the Treaty and its Additional Protocols;

CONSIDERING the existence of favorable conditions to make further progress in strengthening the Tlatelolco System;

NOTING with special interest the tenor of the declaration on the subject made by the Delegation of France at this forum,

Resolves:

TO CALL once again upon the Government of France to proceed as soon as possible to the ratification of Additional Protocol I, thus completing the process of signing and ratification of the Protocols of the Treaty of Tlatelolco.
