

RESOLUTION 279 (XII)

COOPERATION BETWEEN THE NUCLEAR-WEAPON-FREE ZONE IN LATIN AMERICA AND THE CARIBBEAN AND THE SOUTH ATLANTIC PEACE AND COOPERATION ZONE

The General Conference,

TAKING NOTE of the Report of the Secretary General (CG/361);

EMPHASIZING that their identity of purpose confirms the need to establish cooperative links between the South Atlantic Peace and Cooperation Zone and the Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zone in Latin America and the Caribbean that will contribute to their mutual strengthening;

RECALLING Resolution 254 (XI),

Resolves:

1. To INVITE the States Parties to Signatories of the Treaty of Tlatelolco and Parties to Additional Protocols I and II to offer their opinions regarding formulas for the design of mechanisms of collaboration with the South Atlantic Peace and Cooperation Zone.

2. To REQUEST the Secretary General, on the basis of the replies received and in collaboration with the Council, to include in the program of the Thirteenth Regular Session of the General Conference an item entitled "Cooperation between the Latin American and Caribbean Nuclear-Weapon-Free Zone and the South Atlantic Peace and Cooperation Zone".
