## **RESOLUTION 283 (XII)**

### **ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL**

The General Conference,

RECALLING that in accordance with the provisions of Article 10, paragraph 2, of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean, the Members of the Council shall be elected for a term of four years, and that outgoing Members may not be reelected for the following period;

BEARING IN MIND that three of the Members of the Council, Colombia, Mexico and Peru, will complete their term of office in September 1991;

TAKING INTO CONSIDERATION that the Governments of Bolivia, Ecuador and Uruguay have put forward their candidatures to occupy the vacant posts,

Resolves:

TO THANK Colombia, Mexico and Peru for their enthusiastic and active tenure and to accept the candidatures of the Governments of Bolivia, Ecuador and Uruguay and appoint them Members of the Council of OPANAL for a term of four years beginning in September 1991 and ending in September 1995.
