**RESOLUTION 284 (XII)**

**ELECTION OF THE EXTERNAL AUDITOR**

The General Conference,

COMPLYING with the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference and the Financial Rules of OPANAL, which require that the Financial Statements of the Agency be certified annually by an External Auditor;

NOTING that the term for which the current External Auditor was elected expires on December 31, 1991;

CONSIDERING that the Government of Guatemala put forward in good time the candidature of Dr. Gustavo Mirón Porrás to continue in that post;

AWARE of the fact that there is no provision in the Treaty of Tlatelolco, in the Financial Rules, or in the Rules of Procedure of the General Conference, to prevent said reelection from taking place,

Resolves:

1. TO REELECT Dr. Gustavo Mirón Porrás as External Auditor of the Agency for the four-year term from January 1, 1992 to 31 December 1995.
2. TO CONGRATULATE Dr. Gustavo Mirón Porrás on the excellent performance of his duties as External Auditor of the Agency since January 1, 1976, the date on which he was elected by the Fourth Regular Session of the General Conference.
