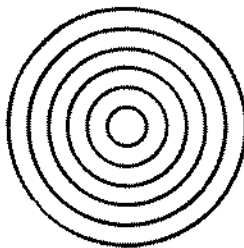

RESOLUTION 306 (XIII)

EXTENSION OF THE MANDATE OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL

The General Conference,

Taking into consideration that Dr. Antonio Stempel Paris was elected to fill the vacancy for the post of Secretary General, following the resignation of the previous Secretary General, Dr. Ricardo Martínez Cobo;

Considering that Dr. Antonio Stempel Paris's first term of office as Secretary General covered three and a half of the four years stipulated in paragraph 1 of Article 11 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco;

Recalling that Dr. Antonio Stempel Paris was reelected to serve a second four-year term of office in accordance with the aforementioned provision of the Treaty;

Considering also that two complete terms of office should span a full eight years, as laid down in the Treaty,

Resolves:

1. **To extend** the mandate of Dr. Antonio Stempel Paris as Secretary General by six months until December 31, 1993, in order to comply with the provisions of paragraph 1 of Article 11 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco.
