RESOLUTION CG/Res.386

THE USE OF NUCLEAR ENERGY FOR PEACEFUL PURPOSES

The General Conference,

Considering that the Treaty of Tlatelolco grants limited authority to OPANAL to address certain issues of current international importance;

Likewise considering Resolution 368 (E-XII), which instructed the Council to study the actions resulting from the Ad Hoc Working Group on the Strengthening of OPANAL that require a process of amendments to the Treaty of Tlatelolco until a definitive decision is made;

Having examined documents CG/494 Report of the Secretary General, CG/495 Report of the Council, and CG/502 the Strengthening of OPANAL,

Resolves:

1. **To issue** a call to all parties interested in this important issue for the future activities of OPANAL to send to the Secretariat General their official position so that they, together with the Council, can continue the study, in an attempt to find the necessary consensus on the issue.
2. **To instruct** the Secretariat General that the results of the study be presented to the next General Conference.
