RESOLUTION CG/RES. 414
APPLICATION OF ARTICLE 24*

The General Conference,

Recalling the obligation of the Governments of the Member States of keeping the Agency informed regarding all of the agreements, or accords or arrangements of any type, bilateral or multilateral, that they have entered into in the field of nuclear cooperation amongst themselves or with third party states, in order to register them or notify the other Contracting Parties.

Observing with satisfaction that the governments of the Member States have met their obligations in this regard in light of Article 24 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco;

Also recalling the need to have all of the international agreements, treaties, accords or arrangements of any type, entered into by the Contracting Parties regarding the issues related to the Treaty of Tlatelolco reported to the Agency in compliance with Article 24 of the Treaty;

Considering that agreements of any type in reference to this subject, entered into by the respective States or public entities, at the charge of or in representation of their Governments, are included in the cases referred to in Article 24 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean.

Resolves:

1. **To reiterate** to the Governments of the Member States the need for strict compliance with Article 24 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco and the resolutions adopted by the General Conference

regarding this issue, by notifying the Secretariat General of OPANAL of all international agreements, treaties, accords or arrangements of any type regarding those issues to which the Treaty refers entered into by the Member States or by public entities in their representation.

2. **To request** the Secretary General to keep the Council and the XVIII Regular General Conference of OPANAL informed regarding the results of these efforts.
