RESOLUTION CG/RES. 422
ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS
AND ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY MATTERS

The General Conference,

Taking into consideration the Report of the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters (Doc. CG/538);

Bearing in mind Article 12 of the Financial Rules of OPANAL;

Considering that for the four-year term from January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2003, Chile, Jamaica, Mexico, Peru and Venezuela were elected as Members of the CCAAP per Resolution 392 (XVI);

Considering also that per Resolution 404 (E-XIV) Argentina, Brazil and Colombia, were elected for one year ending December 31, 2001,

Resolves:

- 1. To elect** as Members of the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters of OPANAL, the Government of the Republic of Argentina, the Federative Republic of Brazil, and the Republic of Panama, for a one-year term from January 1, 2002 to December 31, 2002 in order for them, aside from the functions conferred by the Treaty of Tlatelolco to the CCAAP and those assigned by the General Conference, to survey the proper operation of the Financial Rules in conformity with the provisions of such Treaty and with the decisions adopted

by the General Conference.

2. **To thank** the Government of the Republic of Colombia for its dedication and active participation as Member of the Committee of Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters during year 2001.
