RESOLUTION CG/Res.519
ELECTION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind that according to the provisions of Article 10 paragraph 2 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, the Members of the Council shall remain in their post for a period of 4 years and that outgoing members may not be reelected for the subsequent period;

Considering that two of the Members of the Council, Argentina and Mexico, conclude their mandate on 31 December 2009, elected by Resolution CG/Res.480 (XIX-05) of the General Conference, held in Santiago de Chile;

Bearing in mind that the Governments of Costa Rica and Guatemala have presented their candidacies to occupy the vacant posts on the Council,

Resolves:

1. **To elect** by acclamation Costa Rica and Guatemala as Members of the Council of OPANAL for a period of four years from 1 January 2010 to 31 December 2013 in order that, in addition to the powers that the Treaty of Tlatelolco confers on the Council and those assigned to it by the General Conference, they watch over the good functioning of the Control System in accordance with the provisions of the Treaty itself and with the provisions adopted by the General Conference.
2. **To express its gratitude** to the Governments of Argentina and Mexico for their efficient and enthusiastic work as Members of the Council of OPANAL.
