RESOLUTION CG/E/Res.406 ELECTION OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL

The General Conference,

Taking into consideration paragraph 1, Article 11 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, which establishes that the Secretariat shall consist of a Secretary General whose term of office shall be four years and that he may be re-elected for a single additional term;

Considering that the second term of Ambassador Enrique Roman Morey should have been concluded on December 31, 2001;

Recognizing the benefits of avoiding two elections for Secretary General in less than one year;

Taking into account that H.E. Mr. Edmundo Vargas Carreño has been proposed as candidate for Secretary General by the Government of Chile;

Considering that there must be a direct correlation between the provisions of the Treaty and the will to represent the Agency,

Resolves:

- 1. To unanimously elect H.E. Mr. Edmundo Vargas Carreño as Secretary General for the period from June 1 to December 31, 2001, to comply with paragraph 1, Article 11 of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean (Treaty of Tlatelolco).
- **2. To extend** this term up to December 31, 2005 based on Article 9, numeral 2, literal c of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean (Treaty of Tlatelolco).
