Resolution

Election of two Members of the Council

General Conference,

Bearing in mind Article 10, paragraph 2, of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean – Treaty of Tlatelolco;

Considering that two Members of the Council; Argentina and Uruguay, elected by Resolution CG/Res.02/2019 are close to ending their mandates on the 31 of December, 2021;

Bearing in mind with satisfaction that Guatemala and Brazil submitted their candidacies for the Council for the period covering from 1 January 2022 to 31 December 2025;

Considering that the Members of the Council, together with the Secretary-General, ensure the proper functioning of the Control System and carry out the functions conferred to it by the Treaty of Tlatelolco, as well as those assigned to it by the General Conference.

Resolves:

1. **To elect** by acclamation, as Members of the Council, the Federative Republic of Brazil and Republic of Guatemala for a four-year term from the 1 of January, 2022 to the 31 of December, 2025.

2. **To recognize and thank** the effective work and efforts carried out by the Governments of Argentina and Uruguay as Members of the Council.
