### Resolution

## Coordination of the work of OPANAL in Geneva, New York, Vienna, and to the Caribbean

### The General Conference,

Acknowledging the importance of the OPANAL's Coordinations at the United Nations headquarters in Geneva, New York and Vienna to support the Agency's participation in meetings and events is invited to and to serve as liaison between OPANAL and the different instances at these headquarters;

**Recognizing** that the Member States together with the Secretariat promote the inclusion and participation of Member States that do not have a representation in Mexico City, through the use of remote connection technologies;

**Taking note** of the Report of the Secretary-General contained in document CG/07/2023 "Coordination of the work of OPANAL";

### **Resolves:**

- 1. **To thank** the Governments of Brazil, Ecuador and Mexico for the excellent works in the coordination they have carried out in 2023 at the headquarters in New York, Geneva, and Vienna respectively.
- 2. To welcome the offer of Brazil, to maintain the coordination of OPANAL in New York.
- 3. To welcome the offer of Ecuador, to maintain the coordination of OPANAL in Geneva.
- 4. To welcome the offer of Mexico, to maintain the coordination of OPANAL in Vienna.
- 5. **To establish** a mechanism for coordinating the work of OPANAL in the Caribbean which will be exercised on a voluntary basis by the Member States and will not generate any financial obligation to the Agency, in order to promote inclusiveness and participation of the

Caribbean Member States that do not have representation in Mexico City. Its scope and work modality will be established by the Council during the first half of 2024.

6. **To reiterate** the importance of the OPANAL Coordinations in the different headquarters of the United Nations and to the Caribbean and to continue, through them, with the tasks of representation, promotion and dissemination of the work carried out by OPANAL.
