Report on the Election of the Members of the Council

- 1. The Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean sets forth in Article 10, paragraphs 1 and 2 that:
 - "1. The Council shall be composed of five Members of the Agency elected by the General Conference from among the Contracting Parties, due account being taken of equitable geographic distribution.
 - 2. The Members of the Council shall be elected for a term of four years [...] Outgoing Members may not be re-elected for the following period [...]".
- 2. On 31 December 2015, Argentina, Ecuador, and Venezuela will conclude their terms as Members of the Council, having been elected for the period 2012-2015 by the General Conference through Resolution CG/Res.539 (XXII Regular Session held on 17 November 2011).
- 3. Mexico and Paraguay will remain as Members of the Council until 31 December 2017 pursuant to Resolution CG/E/565 (XXII Special Session held on 7 November 2013).
- 4. As a result, the General Conference shall elect three new Members of the Council for the period 2016-2019 at its XXIV Regular Session (to be held on 26 November 2015).
- 5. On 10 September 2015 the Secretariat circulated letter number S-227/2015 through which it extended an invitation to Member States to submit their candidacies for membership on the Council.
- 6. On 24 September 2015, the Secretariat sent letter number S-246/2015 to all Member States informing them that, through letter number 5-19-E/14 dated 22 September 2015, the Government of Peru submitted its candidacy for membership on the Council.

- 7. On 28 September 2015, the Secretariat transmitted letter number S-255/2015 to all Member States informing them that, through letter number 762, dated 25 September 2015, the Government of Guatemala submitted its candidacy for membership on the Council.
- 8. On 8 October 2015, the Secretariat circulated letter number S-263/2015 to all Member States informing them that, through letter number 043, dated 8 October 2015, the Government of Brazil submitted its candidacy for membership on the Council.
