

RESOLUTION 84 (IV)

Possible relationship of OPANAL with other denuclearized zones

The General Conference,

Having carefully examined the Memorandum of the Secretary General presented in document CG/119;

Taking note with the outmost interest in that a full study on the matter of nuclear-weapons-free zones in all its aspects is being done by mandate of the General Assembly of the United Nations, established in its Resolution 3261 F (XXIX); a study which shall be submitted to the General Assembly during its XXX Period of Sessions beginning an September, 1975, and

Foreseeing the possibility that the Ad Hoc Group of governmental experts carrying out said study under the auspices of the Conference of the Disarmament Commission, may request at a given moment the points of view of this Agency,

Resolves:

- 1. **To ask** the Secretary General that, in the light of the Agency's experience and in consultation with the Council, give the broadest cooperation that might be requested for the full study on the matter of establishing nuclear-weapons free Zones in other regions of the world.
- **2.** *To require* the Governments of Member States, if it would be the case, to give their cooperation to the Secretary General so he may fulfill the mandate referred to in paragraph 1 above.
