APPLICATION OF ARTICLE 24

MEMORANDUM OF THE SECRETARY GENERAL

- Article 24 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco stipulates that, once the Treaty has entered into force, the Secretariat shall be notified immediately of any international agreement concluded by any of the Contracting Parties on matters with which the Treaty is concerned; the Secretariat shall register it and notify the other Contracting Parties.
- 2. The fulfillment of this provision allows not only the Secretary General but also the Agency's Council to comply with the provisions to facilitate the efficient operation of the Control System established by the Treaty of Tlatelolco.
- 3. The Council's Report provides detailed information about the notifications received by the Secretariat General. (Doc. CG/586).
