RESOLUTION CG/Res.472

STATUS OF THE CONVENTION ON PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES OF THE AGENCY

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind Resolutions 245 (XI) of 27 April 1989, 279 (XII) of 10 May 1991, 294 (XIII) of 27 May 1993, 327 (XIV) of 29 March 1995, 354 (XV) of 10 July 1997, 383 (XVI) of 30 November 1999, 411 (XVII) of 29 November 2001 and 440 of 5 November 2003 (XVIII), all of which have repeatedly called upon the Governments of the Member States that are not full Parties to the Convention on Privileges and Immunities of the Agency to sign and/or ratify said instrument as soon as possible;

Having carefully examined the status of signature and ratification of the Convention, as presented in the Memorandum of the Secretary General, Document CG/588,

Resolves:

- To take note with satisfaction of the signature by the Government of the Federative Republic
 of Brazil on 4 February 2004 and of the deposit of the instrument of ratification by the
 Government of the Republic of El Salvador, 28 July 2004, of the Convention on Privileges and
 Immunities of OPANAL.
- 2. **To request** the Member States that have yet to sign or ratify the Convention do so as soon as possible so that the Agency's legal statute may enter into force in each of the Member States that it may fully perform its functions.

3. **To request also** that the Secretary General of OPANAL renew his efforts with the Member States to complete the process of signature or ratification of the Convention and ensure the full entry into force of said international instrument and inform the Council and the XX Regular Session of the General Conference of his efforts.
