RESOLUTION CG/Res.541

**ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE ON CONTRIBUTIONS AND
ADMINISTRATIVE AND BUDGETARY MATTERS**

The General Conference,

Bearing in mind the Report of the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters (CCAAP) (Doc. CG/645) and Article 12 “Principles governing the activities of CCAAP” of the Financial Regulations of OPANAL;

Taking into account that Belize, Brazil and Guatemala would end their term as CCAAP Members on 31 December 2011; having been re-elected for four years by Resolution CG/Res.501 (XX-07);

Considering that for the four-year term beginning on 1 January 2007 and ending on 31 December 2011, Cuba and Nicaragua were elected by Resolution CG/Res.501 (XX-07);

Compliant with Article 12 section a) “*The States that have been Members of the CCAAP for two consecutive terms in four years are not eligible for an additional period of four years.*”

Resolves:

1. **To elect** the Governments of the Plurinational Republic of Bolivia, the Republic of Chile and the United Mexican States as Members of the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters of OPANAL for a four-year term beginning on 1 January 2012 and ending on 31 December 2015.

2. **To re-elect** the Governments of Cuba and Nicaragua as Members of the Committee on Contributions and Administrative and Budgetary Matters of OPANAL for an additional four-year term beginning on 1 January 2012 and ending on 31 December 2015.
3. **To thank** the Governments of Belize, Brazil, Cuba, Guatemala and Nicaragua for their effective work as CCAAP Members.
4. **To acknowledge** the support from Member States and Observers of CCAAP and their cooperation on the efforts made for the appropriate management and financial functioning of the Agency.
5. **To encourage** CCAAP Members to continue ensuring the appropriate management and financial functioning of the Agency, in accordance with the dispositions adopted by the General Conference and the Financial Regulations.
6. **To request** the Secretariat General to inform all Member States about the content of this resolution.
