**RESOLUTION CG/E/Res.565**  
**ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL**

**The General Conference,**

**Recalling** that under the provisions of Article 10 Section 2 of the Treaty of Tlatelolco, the period for Members of the Council will last four years and outgoing Members shall not be eligible for *immediate re-election*;

**Considering** that two Members of the Council, Guatemala and Costa Rica, elected by its Resolution CG/Res.519 adopted in November 2009, shall end their term on 31 December 2013;

**Bearing in mind** that the Governments of Mexico and Paraguay have submitted their candidatures for Members of the Council,

**Resolves:**

1. **To elect**, by acclamation, the Governments of Mexico and Paraguay as Members of the Council of OPANAL for a four-year period, covering from 1 January 2014 to 31 December 2017, in order to comply with the Council functions established under the Treaty of Tlatelolco and with those assigned by the General Conference, and to ensure the proper functioning of the Control System according to the provisions of the Treaty and the General Conference.
2. **To especially thank** the Governments of Guatemala and Costa Rica for their enthusiastic and effective participation as Members of the Council of OPANAL.
3. **To request** the Secretariat General to inform all Member States about the content of this Resolution.
