Resolution

Internship Programme at the Secretariat

The General Conference,

Considering its Resolution CG/Res.479, adopted by the XIX Session of the General Conference on 8 November 2005, and Resolution CG/Res.518, adopted by the XXI Session of the General Conference on 26 November 2009, which urges Member States to implement the recommendations of the “United Nations Study on Disarmament and Non-proliferation Education”¹; to continue the dissemination work of the Treaty for the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons in Latin America and the Caribbean (Treaty of Tlatelolco) and to promote the education activities that allow to contribute to the education for peace, nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation.

Bearing in mind the Declaration of Member States of OPANAL on the occasion of the International Day for the Total Elimination of Nuclear Weapons, on 26 September 2020, in which the Member States of the Agency “*undertake to continue to work for the implementation of nuclear disarmament and non-proliferation education programmes, convinced that they are an effective means for contributing to the consolidation of international peace and security*”;

Considering also its Resolution CG/10/2019 of 7 November 2019, in which it resolved to invite again Member States to publicize and support the internship programme and to submit nominations.

Resolves:

1. **To thank** the Member States that have submitted nominations to participate in the internship programme.
2. **To express** its appreciation to the Kingdom of the Netherlands, State Party to Additional Protocol I to the Treaty of Tlatelolco, for the support that it has been giving to the participation of Caribbean States in the internship programme.
3. **To support** the interns with monthly amount of MXN 1000 as incentive and recognition of their constant work during their period at OPANAL.
4. **To invite** again Member States to publicize and support the internship programme of the Agency and to submit nominations.
